

HIV IN MARYLAND

In 2021, there were **33,467 people living with HIV** in Maryland. That same year, **749 people were newly diagnosed with HIV**.





Rates of Persons Living with HIV per 100k, 2021




New HIV Diagnoses & PrEP Use

Pre-exposure prophylaxis, or **PrEP, can protect people from acquiring HIV**. We know that PrEP works in reducing new HIV diagnoses. Yet, PrEP use is not equitable. For example, **Black people represented half (49%) of new HIV diagnoses in the South, yet were only 21% of PrEP users in the region**.










Viral HIV Suppression

Viral suppression is defined as **those living with diagnosed HIV who had suppressed HIV viral load** (<200 copies/mL).


Number of people living with HIV who were virally suppressed in Maryland, 2021: Percent of people living with HIV who were virally suppressed in Maryland, 2021:


Proportion of people virally suppressed in Maryland, by Race/Ethnicity, 2021
